West African Resources files NI 43-101 Technical Report: Sanbrado Gold Project, Burkina Faso

Perth, Western Australia: Gold developer West African Resources Limited (ASX, TSXV: WAF) is pleased to advise that it has today filed a National Instrument 43-101 (NI 43-101) Technical Report (Technical Report) regarding the 30 October 2017 resource upgrade for the Sanbrado Gold Project, Burkina Faso, as required by Canadian securities regulations.
